





Mounting Instructions



How to Install How to Install

▲ Warning!

It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber.

⚠ When installing, read the Vehicle Service Manual.

Mhen working on a raised vehicle, ensure that the vehicle is securely supported so that it will not tip.

O Note!

To make the following procedure easier, we recommend you to perform the following steps on **both sides** at the same time.

1

Remove the wheel.

2

Remove the anti-roll bar link at the lower joint.

3

Remove the brake hose attachment.

4

Disconnect the PASM wire to the shock absorber. The wire is located at the lower end of the original shock absorber.

5

Remove the brake caliper and support it so that the brake hose can not be damaged, for instance by hanging it on a piece of bent welding rod.

6

Remove the standard strut. First loosen the upper mount (three nuts). Remove the upper mount from the strut.

7

Loosen the lower attachment bolts to the original shock absorber.

8

Push the shock absorber and A-arm down to enable the shock absorber to be angled outward without it hitting the fender. 9

Remove the shock absorber by pulling it out of the upright bracket.

10

Install the springs and provided parts on the shock absorber according to figure 11.

11


Install the Öhlins shock absorber in the upright bracket with the reservoir bracket pointing towards the rear.

12

Angle the shock absorber in under the fenders.

13

Tighten the upper attachment nut.



14

Reattach the anti-roll bar link.

15

Install spacer 00426-01, provided in this kit, to achieve more space against the reservoir tube. See figure. Reattach the brake hose.

16

Reattach the wheel speed sensor harness.

17

Reattach the brake caliper.

18

Reinstall the wheel.

19

Carefully shrink the heat shrinkable end cap over the PASM connector to protect it.



20

After installing all shock absorbers (front and rear), check the vehicle ride height. If necessary, adjust (See section Spring Preload in the Öhlins Owner's Manual. Consult the vehicle service manual for recommended ride height.

Caution!

Make sure that all bolts are tightened to the correct torque and that there are no binds and that nothing restricts movement of the shock absorber when the suspension is being fully compressed or extended.





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How to Install Adjustments

Remove the wheel.

Note!

Be sure to note the position of the bearing spacers for the anti-roll bar link.

2

Remove the anti-roll bar.

3

Disconnect the PASM wire to the shock absorber. The wire is located at the lower end of the original shock absorber.

4

Remove the three upper attachment nuts of the original shock absorber.

5

Remove the toe-in stay.

6


Remove the lower bolt of the original shock absorber. Remove the shock absorber.

7

Install the springs and provided parts on the shock absorber according to figure 1.

8

Install the Öhlins shock absorber with the bracket pointing down and adjusters towards the wheel well. Tighten the upper attachment nut first.



9

Insert the lower attachment bolt through the suspension arm and the shock absorber.

10

Reattach the anti-roll bar link.

• Note!

Be sure to reinstall the bearing spacers for the anti-roll bar link in the proper position (see step 2).

11

Tighten the lower attachment nut.

12

Reinstall the wheel.

13

Carefully shrink the heat shrinkable end cap over the PASM connector to save it from dirt.

• Note!

Since the original shock absorber and electric wire is disconnected there will be a error indication on the dashboard "PASM failure". Please contact a Porsche dealer to have the message turned off.

14

After installing all shock absorbers (front and rear), check the vehicle ride height. If necessary, adjust (See section Spring Preload in the Öhlins Owner's Manual. Read the vehicle service manual for recommended ride height.
